Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

How will attendance be taken for my child(ren)?

Attendance will vary depending on the grade level and/or teacher. As the Distance Learning begins, teachers will provide expectations for students as to how they meet the attendance requirements. The requirement could change from day to day as well. It could be responding to an email, participating in a video conference, completing an assignment, or other forms of documented attendance.

What are the daily student expectations?

Students and/or parents should look for electronic communication on a daily basis from their child(ren)'s teachers. This communication could be through email, google classroom, schoology, or other platforms teachers are using.

How will teachers assess my child(ren)'s work?

Teachers will assess student work in a variety of ways. It may include work completion and proficiency, written responses, short formative checks for understanding, etc.

How will Distance Learning work if my child doesn't have access to the internet?

Teachers will continue to communicate with students through phone conversations to support students. Learning packets will be delivered by the district to those students without internet access to provide opportunities for learning. The district is working to find ways to provide internet to those families that don't currently have access. Unfortunately, supplies are low across the country.

How can I set my child(ren) up for success in the Distance Learning environment?

The district understands the issues some families face with both parents still working and having multiple children who have homework to complete. We would encourage you to:

- Create a learning space
- Create a schedule for the day
- Create a checklist for the day's activities
- Ask to see their work

How will my child(ren) interact with teachers online?

There will be several different digital tools used by teachers in the district. Most teachers have identified one or two tools they will use throughout this time period to interact with their students. The communication tool to be used will be shared with students by their teacher.
