Eligibility: To be eligible for a Samantha Chase Schaeherer Scholarship you must be a current student of GFW High School who is pursuing a course of study in **medicine or health care sciences** and/or demonstrate significant financial need.

Application Instructions: Your complete scholarship application will include:

- 1) Completed SCS Scholarship Application-2019
- 2) Essay responses to questions 1-7.
- 3) High school transcript

Deadline to the Career Center is Wednesday, April 17, 2019.

Application Considerations: Applicants to the Samantha Chase Schaeherer Scholarship Fund should be committed to the pursuit of a four-year college degree. The selection committee places high value on demonstrated perseverance, desire for personal growth and financial resourcefulness. Solid students, especially those with financial need should apply.

*If chosen, you will receive your award over four years, provided you remain eligible by maintaining a 2.85, or higher, GPA.

Scholarship recipients will receive the first monetary installment after their first and subsequent semester grades are posted. You will need to mail your transcripts/grades to the Career Center in order to receive your award.
