Research and read about a famous Minnesotan. Follow the directions in Google Classroom and use Google Slides to create a presentation with 4 slides.	Write 6 sentences that use the following types of figurative language: personification, idiom, hyperbole, allusion, metaphor, and simile. After each example, label and explain the meaning of each type of figurative language. Google Doc	Find a recipe and write the entire recipe down. Then calculate the amount of each ingredient needed to make 1 ½ batches of the recipe. Record in the classroom Google Doc or write it out on paper.	Place a chunk of snow or ice in a container or cup. Put the container in a sink, tub, or shower. Use a timer to document how long it took to change from a solid to a liquid. Check it every 2 minutes. Record your results in the Google Doc or on paper.	Find a state park or landmark to visit in Minnesota. Select a picture of the park or landmark and write a paragraph that summarizes the important details using the Google Doc in Classroom.
